Information and Support

Applicants are encouraged to contact Student and Learning Services for support throughout the admission process. Selection Process

Nature Care College does not require students to have any specific prior knowledge or a particular Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) for course entry.

Entry Requirements

- To qualify for admission, course entry for Advanced Diploma, Diploma and Professional Certificates & Certificates courses is through high school matriculation or mature age entry of 21 years and over.
- Prior to enrolment you can request an appointment with a Course Advisor to gain a full understanding of the courses before applying.

How to Enrol:

- In order to enrol, complete this 'Initial Application for Enrolment Form.
- Refer to the recommended Study Plans for enrolment recommendation. The Study Plans lists the subjects you need to enrol into for your first term of study. You enrol on a term by term basis as you progress with your studies.
- Choose your study options, class days and times for each subject for your first term of enrolment from the A-Z timetable listing

- To reserve your place in a course programme an initial deposit of \$500 of your first term tuition fees together with the \$95.00 Professional Training Enrolment Fee is required to secure your place **or** if the course programme only has one subject per term to reserve your place a 50% deposit is required upon enrolment
- The remaining course fees for all subjects within the term are due by the end of the first week of term unless you have submitted a formal payment plan form.
- Before you lodge your 'Initial Application for Enrolment Form' please ensure you have read the Enrolment Terms & Conditions outlined on the back of the form.

Acceptance

- If you would like an appointment with a Course Advisor prior to enrolling a Course Advisor will contact you to arrange a suitable time.
- Once you have submitted your completed Initial Application for Enrolment Form you will receive a Confirmation of Enrolment email confirming your enrolment

Payment Options for Advanced Diploma, Professional Certificate and Certificate Courses

Pay Upfront to receive a discount:

Pay the whole terms course tuition fee in full upfront upon enrolment to receive a 5% discount on the course terms tuition fees

Spread the Cost of Your Course Throughout the Term:

To reserve your place in a course programme an initial deposit of \$500 of your first term tuition fees together with the \$95.00 Professional Training Enrolment Fee is required to secure your place **or** if the course programme only has one subject per term to reserve your place a 50% deposit is required upon enrolment

A payment plan provides you with the option of spreading the cost of your terms tuition fee throughout the whole term in weekly instalments (12 weeks of term and including 1 week recess means you can spread of cost of your terms fees over 13 weeks).

To be eligible to re-enrol all payment plan obligations must be finalised by the end of term. A payment plan attracts a 10% surcharge which is applied to the balance outstanding after the first week of term.

Extended Payment Plan - Available for NCC Advanced Diploma Courses only

- Would you like to study a high level qualification but cannot afford the upfront tuition fees?
- An extended Payment plan provides you with the option of paying reduced tuition fee instalments each term allowing you to accrue your outstanding balance until you graduate enabling you to study now and pay later.
- To reserve your place pay the initial deposit of \$500 for your first terms tuition fees together with the \$95.00 Professional Training Enrolment Fee.

Full time Study Plans:

An extended payment plan provides you with the option of paying \$100.00 per week towards your course tuition fees throughout the whole term. The outstanding balance accrues each term allowing you to defer the balance until you graduate.

Part-time Study Plans:

An extended payment plan provides you with the option of paying \$75.00 per week towards your course tuition fees throughout the whole term. The outstanding balance accrues each term allowing you to defer the balance until you graduate

- There is a 10% surcharge fee on the total balance of tuition fees accrued at the end of your studies.
- To be eligible to graduate accrued balances must be finalised in full

Enrolment Terms & Conditions

In order to enrol, return your Initial Application for Enrolment Form to Nature Care College.

1. To reserve your place in a course an initial deposit of \$500 deposit of your first term tuition fees together with the \$95 Enrolment Fee per qualification is required to secure your place.
2. Remaining course fees for all subjects within a term, are due **by the end of the first week of term**. Unless you have submitted a formal payment plan form. Non compliance will result in you being not eligible to re-enrol or to receive an Academic Record or Certificate until all outstanding fees have been finalised.
3. All fees are non-refundable and non-transferable unless a subject is cancelled by Nature Care College, in this instance a full refund is provided.
4. **Cancellation/Withdrawal Policy:** Course Credits can be granted for course fees paid, less a \$40 administration fee per subject provided advice of withdrawal is received in writing prior to the commencement of term (i.e. before Monday of week one (1) of term or one (1) week prior to the commencement of an intensive or workshop). Please advise the reason for withdrawal with supporting documentation. Choose your courses carefully as unfortunately we cannot accept responsibility for changes in your personal circumstances or work commitments which occur after the commencement of your course. Any course fees outstanding are still due and payable.
5. **Transfers:** A transfer is defined as either a change from one course to another within the same term or changing times within the same subject. No fee applies to transfers. Transferring is possible between a distance learning subject and an on campus subject within the first two (2) weeks of term, beyond the first two (2) weeks of term transfers can no longer occur between programs.
6. A 10% late surcharge penalty is applied to any outstanding balance at the end of the first week of term unless you have submitted a formal payment plan form for an Advanced Diploma course.
7. To assist your budget, fees are charged on a per term basis rather than annually upfront. All continuing students are required to re-enrol each term at least one week prior to the start of term.
8. The College reserves the right to vary course structure, teaching staff, adjust fees or class schedules at any time. It is at the College's discretion to discontinue offering a course or subject as deemed necessary.
9. The College reserves the right to cancel a course, or refuse any enrolment as permitted by law.
10. As an NCC student you will need to have a Windows or Mac computer with access to the internet. The e-learning management system that the college uses works well with different operating systems, but the latest version of Windows or Mac OSX are recommended.
11. By enrolling in a course at the College, students agree to be bound by the Enrolment Terms and Conditions and College Policies as outlined in the Student Handbook.
