Payment Plan Contract Terms and Conditions

- An extended payment plan provides you with the option of paying reduced tuition fee installments each term for the duration of your studies allowing you to accrue your outstanding balances until you graduate enabling you to study now and pay later.
- An extended payment plan provides you with the option of paying \$100.00 per week towards your course tuition fees throughout the entire Term. (Term consists of 12 weeks plus 1-week recess = 13 installments each Term)
The outstanding balance accrues each term allowing you to defer the balance until you graduate.
- A 10% surcharge fee is payable on the total balance of tuition fees accrued at the end of your studies
- To be eligible to graduate the accrued balance must be finalised in full prior to graduation
- Non-compliance of weekly installments will result in all outstanding fees becoming due and payable immediately.
- If you withdraw from the course and cease your studies, all accrued balances are payable in full
